Of all code violations, high grass and weeds are the most reoccurring problem throughout Texas cities. High grass and weeds detract from the aesthetic appearance of our community and they create a potential fire, safety, and health issue. High grass and weeds also create and promote the risk of rodent and insect infestations.

City residents are asked to take the time to trim and mow their lawns and monitor their property to ensure compliance. According to the City's Code of Ordinances, ten (10) inches is the maximum length of growth for high grass and weeds. Any property that has grass and weeds taller than ten inches is declared a nuisance.
