



Cemetery Clean-up

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. What will be picked up during the clean-up?

A. All floral arrangements, plastic or living, will be removed from all cemeteries, including the mausoleum at the discretion of the Cemetery Superintendent. Decorations that are damaged, wilted, and unsightly will also be disposed of.

Q. What will be left alone?

A. The Parks Division will not remove vases, wind chimes, trees, ornaments, shrubbery, and benches as long as the items are not considered objectionable and are in good condition.

Q. If I want to keep personal items, what should I do?

A. It is recommended that any decorations citizens wish to keep for later use should be removed before April 3, 2017.

Q. When can I put decorations back on the graves?

A. After April 7, 2017, decorations may be placed back on graves.

Q. What about burials that occur during this week?

A. An exception will be made for burials that occur during the week of April 3rd – 7th.

Q. Why is the City now doing this?

A. The new community engagement opportunity will reinforce Parks Maintenance Division's efforts in the upkeep and functionality of our community cemeteries. The project will improve the aesthetic of Hondo's sole municipal cemetery which is designed and maintained for the living as well as our beloved ones who have passed on.
