Advertisement and Invitation for Bids

The City of Hondo will receive bids for CDBG Sanitary Sewer Improvements until **2:00 pm** on **September 16th** at the City of Hondo (Att: Miguel Cantu, City Secretary, 1600 Ave. M, Hondo, Texas 78861) at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at **2:00 pm** on **September 16th**. The deadline for questions/clarifications to be submitted to the engineer will be **2:00 pm Monday September 7th**. The engineer's opinion of probable cost for the project is \$237,000.

Major items and quantities of work are as follows:

1. Construction of approximately 704 L.F. of sanitary sewer line along 12th St.
2. Construction of approximately 707 L.F. of sanitary sewer line along 13th St.
3. Installation of 3 new manholes along 12th St
4. Installation of 3 new manholes along 13th St
5. Installation of 653 L.F. of sanitary sewer laterals.

Additionally, the bid set may be viewed and downloaded on or after **August 27, 2020**, online (free of charge) by registering with www.CivCastUSA.com. Following registration, complete sets of documents may be downloaded from the CivCast website as "zipped" portable document format (PDF) files. The City of Hondo will not provide paper copies of the bid set.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to the **City of Hondo** or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond. Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin.

The City of Hondo reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by City of Hondo for a period not to exceed 30 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award. The city is an Equal Opportunity Employer.
