XLR8 PROGRAM

EDC is participating in University of Texas at Austin XLR8 Program: Regional XLR8 – a new type of “accelerator” for community economic development. In the XLR8 program, community/Economic Development leaders are invited to participate where they will identify opportunities for growth benefitting from regional assets, building on regional collaborations and impacting community economic and quality of life. Regional XLR8 builds on IC2 Institute’s 40+ years of “thinking and doing,” where best entrepreneurial practices are defined and applied to regional economic development resulting in >\$4.5B in economic impact. In XLR8, community leaders will be able to develop new programs, rapidly measure outcomes, and refine for maximum impact.
