



Brush pick up is the same day as your garbage pick-up on the first week of each month:

- Monday – South side of Hwy 90 East of Ave M.
- Tuesday – South side of Hwy 90, West of Ave M and East of Ave U.
- Wednesday – South of Hwy 90, West of Ave U and North side of Hwy 90 East of Ave M.
- Thursday – North of Hwy 90 and West of Ave M and South of 14<sup>th</sup> Street
- Friday – North of 14<sup>th</sup> Street and West of Ave M

Any brush pick-up that exceeds the allotted amount must be prepaid at:

City Hall 1600 Avenue M.

Monday-Friday; 8am-5pm  
(Closed on observed holidays)

# Brush Pick-up

Everything you need to know about Hondo's brush collection service.

## Overview

Brush pick-up is provided to all City of Hondo residential customers who receive garbage services from the City. Commercial accounts can contact Hilda Juarez with Republic Services directly to request a quote for brush pick-up. Ms. Juarez can be reached at 830-423-3168.

## How Often Should I Expect Pick-up?

This service is provided once a month per residential garbage customer.

## When Is My Scheduled Pick-up?

Brush will be picked up the first full week of each month on the day your garbage is picked up. The first week starts with the first Monday of each month.

## Do I Still Need To Call In For A Work Order?

Work-orders are no longer necessary for piles under 8 cubic yards. For those piles over 8 cubic yards that need the fees paid, work-orders will be entered once fees are paid in full at City Hall located at 1600 Ave M.

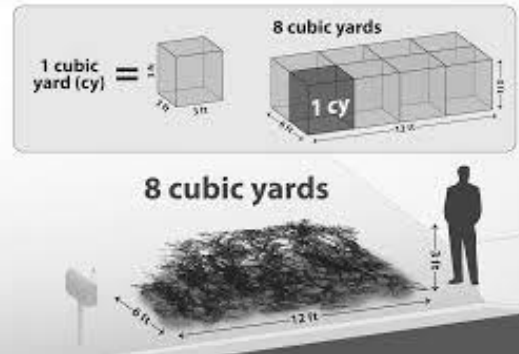

## How Much Brush Can I Put Out?

- Must be manageable, approximately eight (8) cubic yards or less. You may exceed this amount in a single pick-up, only if the additional fee(s) is paid in advance; \$5 per every extra 2 cubic yards. Payments are made at City Hall 1600 Ave M.
- Brush must be cut into lengths not to exceed 4 feet long and 9 inches in diameter.

## Where Can I Put My Brush?

- Brush should be placed in the front or side of the home, next to the street and behind the curb.
- Do not place brush:
  - In front of parked cars
  - On top of meters, manholes, drainage channels
  - Along fences or mailboxes
  - In the alley or on vacant lots
  - Directly underneath powerlines or any location that may cause damage to either private or public property.
  - Brush must not block car or pedestrian traffic or block public access. (No street placement allowed)



## I Hired A Contractor, Will The City Pick-up My Brush?

No, all brush resulting from a contractor hired for tree trimming, pruning, or lawn work must be removed by the contractor, owner, occupant, tenant, or lessee of the premises within 48 hours of completion or be subject to penalty.

## When Can I Put Out My Brush?

Brush can be put out for pick-up no more than 7 days before your scheduled pick-up.

## What If Not All My Pile Was Picked Up?

If your brush pile is larger than 8 cubic yards, only the 8 cubic yards will be picked up and the excess will be left behind. If the limbs are longer than 4 feet long or wider than 9 inches in diameter it will not be picked up. If the excess is paid and the larger limbs are cut prior to close of business on Thursday of the first week, you can call City Hall and we will send a work-order in to have the piles picked up that week. Otherwise, you are responsible for storing the pile until the following month or disposing of the pile yourself.
