Notice is hereby given that a Regular Cemetery Advisory Board of the governing body of the City of Hondo will be held on Monday, April 5, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. at the Council Chambers, City Hall at 1600 Avenue M, Hondo, Texas, for the purpose of discussing matters incident and related to the cemetery. The following items will be discussed, to-wit:

1. Call to order.
2. Quorum check.
3. Board consideration for excusing any member absence.
4. Citizens'/Public Comments: *Persons who desire to address the City of Hondo Cemetery Advisory Board will be received at this time. Those persons wishing to speak should complete a Public Comment Form and submit it to the City Sexton prior to the meeting. If the speaker wishes to comment on a particular agenda item, then the speaker should indicate such item(s) on the form. Public comment is limited to 3 minutes per speaker. Speakers must conduct themselves in a civil manner. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, the City of Hondo Cemetery Advisory Board cannot deliberate or take action on items not listed on the meeting agenda.*
5. Discuss and consider the approval of the meeting minutes from October 5, 2020 regular meeting.
6. Discuss and consider not allowing the placement of the rocks on top of plots in the future. The plots that already have them will be grandfathered in; however; no more will be allowed in the future. (Mary Zerr-Barden)
7. Discuss and consider the board needing to approve large items being placed on plots such as benches and chairs. (Mary Zerr-Barden)
8. Discuss and consider the City of Hondo installing a back flow preventer for the entire cemetery to ensure the irrigation systems do not cause any contamination into the city's water system. (Mary Zerr-Barden)
9. Discuss options to find where the cement cross in the Ingleside Cemetery goes. (Mary Zerr-Barden)
10. Discuss and consider options to take old flags for disposal. (Mary Zerr-Barden)
11. Discuss and consider options for having New Fountain Road (6th Street "Cemetery Road") cleaned up on days funerals are scheduled. Possibly getting with TDCJ community squad and the buildings division, scout programs or other volunteer organizations. (Mary Zerr-Barden)
12. Discuss and consider the possibility of closing some of the existing roads that are not paved. (Len McVay)

13. Discuss and consider having all who are wishing to water their loved ones plots needing to stay at the location and not just leave the water running when they leave. They also need to remove their hoses when they leave. (Len McVay)
