The City of Hondo is actively monitoring and are keeping abreast to the changing conditions of COVID-19. To avoid exposing city staff, court personnel and citizens to the threat of COVID-19; the City of Hondo Municipal Court, in response to the Supreme Court of Texas and the Court of Criminal Appeals of Texas Emergency Order No. 20-007 issued on Friday, March 13, 2020, the City of Hondo will follow the following procedures:

1. The City of Hondo will modify or suspend any and all deadlines and procedures, whether prescribed by statute, rule, or order, for a stated period ending no later than 30 days after the Governor's state of disaster has been lifted.
2. The City of Hondo will take any other reasonable action to avoid exposing court proceedings to the threat of COVID-19 and reset all March and April court cases.
3. The City of Hondo will extend the statute of limitations in any civil case to include city code violations and truancy for a stated period ending no later than 30 days after the Governor's state of disaster has been lifted.
4. This Order is effective as of March 16, 2020, and expires May 8, 2020, unless extended by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Texas.
