Re: Contingent Amendment to the 2013-14 Budget

This memo provides information on amendment(s) requested to the current year budget and provides a projection of year-end balances, based on Budgeted Amounts. A recap of year-to-date amendments and requests is attached to the Ordinance as Exhibit A.

Budget Amendment(s) – Ordinance

The Ordinance authorizes amendment(s) to the City's 2013-14 Budget.

Amendment 18 – Rick Taylor Air Conditioning – The air conditioning system at the Rick Taylor Recreation Center is in need of repair. The projected cost is in the \$20,000 to \$25,000 range. In a previous Council Agenda Item, we recommended the cost of the repairs be covered by the left over 2007 Certificate of Obligation Funds. If that recommended was accepted, this amendment is not needed. If the recommended was not accepted, then we are asking for this budget amendment to be approved.

In closing, we request you approve the ordinance that amends the 2013-14 Budget(s).

ORDINANCE NO. 1038-08-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HONDO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AMENDMENTS TO THE ADOPTED ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF HONDO, TEXAS FOR THE 2013-2014 FISCAL YEAR PROVIDING FOR SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION AND/OR TRANSFER OF CERTAIN FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS; by Ordinance No. 994-09-13, the City of Hondo, Texas, adopted its annual budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year on September 9, 2013; and

WHEREAS; Section 7.08 of the City of Hondo Home Rule Charter provides for amendments after adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS; by Ordinance No. 1001-11-13, the City of Hondo, Texas, amended its annual budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year on November 4, 2013; and

WHEREAS; by Ordinance No. 1002-11-13, the City of Hondo, Texas, amended its annual budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year on November 12, 2013; and

WHEREAS; by Ordinance No. 1003-12-13, the City of Hondo, Texas, amended its annual budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year on December 9, 2013; and

WHEREAS; by Ordinance No. 1005-01-14, the City of Hondo, Texas, amended its annual budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year on January 27, 2014; and

WHEREAS; by Ordinance No. 1009-02-14, the City of Hondo, Texas, amended its annual budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year on February 10, 2014; and

WHEREAS; by Ordinance No. 1018-05-14, the City of Hondo, Texas, amended its annual budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year on May 12, 2014; and

WHEREAS; by Ordinance No. 1020-06-14, the City of Hondo, Texas, amended its annual budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year on June 9, 2014; and

WHEREAS; by Ordinance No. 1034-07-14, the City of Hondo, Texas, amended its annual budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year on July 28 2014; and

WHEREAS; the City Council finds and determines that it is prudent to amend the budget as set forth in this ordinance due to unforeseen conditions that have occurred in the City; and

WHEREAS; the City Council finds that this amendment will serve the general welfare of the citizenry; and

WHEREAS; the City Council deems it advisable to amend the budget for municipal purposes by allocating \$25,000 from the General Fund for Air Conditioning repairs at the Rick Taylor Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS; the amended budget appended here as Exhibit "A", for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014 was duly presented to the City Council by the City Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HONDO, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.


SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to make the amendments set forth in this ordinance to the appropriations for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014, for the support of the general government of the City of Hondo, Texas, a copy of which is appended as Exhibit "A".


SECTION 3. That the budget, as shown in words and figures in Exhibit "A" is hereby approved in all aspects and adopted as the City's amended budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014.

SECTION 4. Should any part of this Ordinance be held to be invalid for any reason, the remainder shall not be affected thereby, and such remaining portions are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. These amendments shall become an attachment to original budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year.
