Notice is hereby given that an Emergency City Council Meeting of the governing body of the City of Hondo will be held April 16, 2020 at 3:15 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall at 1600 Avenue M, Hondo, Texas, for the purpose of amending a statement regarding the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic to include a declaration regarding public and private gatherings, and continuing and affirming the declaration to continue longer than thirty days.



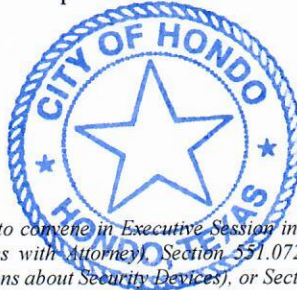
