

Message from the Mayor James W. Danner, Sr. and City Manager Kim Davis

On Tuesday, April 21, the City of Hondo City Council issued the 6th Emergency Decree. The purpose of this decree was to amend the decree to coincide with the latest Executive Order issued by Governor Abbott on Friday, April 17. The Decree allows for non-essential businesses to open, but only if they can provide curbside or delivery services. This change does not allow for restaurants to opening dining rooms. It also does not allow for hair salons, nail salons, gyms, massage or tattoo parlors to open. As both a non-essential business and a consumer, you should be familiar with the Texas Department of State Health Guidelines for re-opening non-essential businesses. Those guidelines may be found at www.dshs.state.tx.us/coronavirus and click on the link for "Guidance to open safely for employees and consumers." You can also visit the City of Hondo website to find the guidance document.

The City of Hondo continues to monitor this situation closely and will work with local and state health officials to try to flatten the curve. We look forward to getting God's Country Working again! As stated before, we work to find balance between public safety and economic viability. Please continue to follow the most up-to-date guidelines for slowing the transmission of the virus.
