Notice is hereby given that a special meeting of the City of Hondo Planning & Zoning Commission will be held on Tuesday, September 24, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the City of Hondo Council Chamber, 1600 Avenue M, Hondo, Texas, for the purpose of discussion and consideration on the items listed below:

1. Call to order.
2. Quorum check.
3. Public Comment. *Persons who desire to address the Planning & Zoning Commission will be received at this time. Those persons wishing to speak should complete a Public Comment Form and submit it to the city secretary prior to the meeting. If the speaker wishes to comment on a particular agenda item, then the speaker should indicate such item(s) to on the form. Public comment is limited to 3 minutes per speaker. Speakers must conduct themselves in a civil manner. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Planning & Zoning Commission cannot deliberate or take action on items not listed on the meeting agenda.*
4. Discuss and consider Case P542-19. Request from Medina County for consideration of a Preliminary Plat titled Medina County Annex Plat, vacating C.J. Bless, Block 1, Lots 1 thru 8, and a 20ft wide alley, and re-platting to create Medina County Annex Plat, Lot A, Block 1. Total 2.066 acres. Property located between Avenue N and Avenue M, and between 13th Street and 14th Street within the Government/Public (GP) Zoning District. (Lora Robbins)
5. Discuss and consider Case P543-19. Request from Charles Baker (Susan and Ivan Alston, owners) for consideration of a Final Plat titled Armadillo Estates Resubdivision, vacating Lots 1-10, Armadillo Estates, and re-platting to create Lots 1A-10A, Armadillo Estates. Total 6.968 acres. Property located at intersection of 30th Street and Armadillo Drive within the Residential Three (R3) Zoning District. (Lora Robbins)
