

ORDINANCE NO. 1019-05-14

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 951-03-12, ESTABLISHING THE ORGANIZATION OF THE BOARD; TERM LIMITS; REAPPOINTMENT; DEFINED DUTIES; THAT MEMBERS SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION; AND APPOINTMENT FOR MEMBER REMOVAL OR VACANCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hondo passed Ordinance 951-03-12 changing the name of the Downtown Advisory Board to the Central Business District Advisory Board ("CBDAB") and established the newly named board's organization, term limits, reappointments, appointments and specifying that Board members serve without compensation.

WHEREAS, the CBDAB was established to provide the City Council with recommendations for beautification, enhancement and revitalization of the City of Hondo's Central Business District and other business areas within the City.

WHEREAS, current CBDAB members and the City agree that the Hondo Area Chamber of Commerce, which is organized to market and promote the City's businesses, is the best organization to direct and govern the Board.

WHEREAS, the Hondo Area Chamber of Commerce's president has agreed to recommend the incorporation of the CBDAB into the Chamber of Commerce as a subcommittee.

WHEREAS, upon the abolishment of the Central Business District Advisory Board, the repeal of Ordinance 951-03-12 adopted on March 26, 2012, establishing the CBDAB is required.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HONDO, TEXAS:

Section 1. The Central Business District Advisory Board is hereby abolished.

Section 2. Ordinance 951-03-12 is hereby repealed in its entirety.


Section 3. SEVERABILITY


Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE
