

ORDINANCE NO. 1035-07-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HONDO, TEXAS AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES APPENDIX A, SECTION A13.111 "SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES" TO CHANGE SUBSECTION (c) "SCHEDULE C. PERMIT FEES FOR CITIZEN'S COLLECTION STATION" TO SUBSECTION (b) "SCHEDULE B. PERMIT FEES FOR CITIZEN'S COLLECTION STATION".

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Hondo, has determined that it was necessary to repeal subsection A13.111 (b) of Appendix A in the City of Hondo Code of Ordinances in its entirety;

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2014, the Hondo City Council passed an ordinance repealing subsection A13.111 (b) in its entirety;

WHEREAS, as a result of the repealing of subsection A13.111 (b), and in order to provide clarity in the succession of referenced schedules of rates and fees in Section A13.111 of Appendix A, the City Council has determined that it is necessary to change and move forward the last subsection A13.111 (c) to subsection A13.111(b);

WHEREAS, as a result of changing subsection A13.111(c) to (b), the title to the new subsection (b) will read, "Schedule B. Permit Fees for Citizens Collection Station"; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the above findings, the City Council has determined after due deliberation, that changing subsection A13.111(c) to A.13.111 (b) and Schedule C to Schedule B in Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances would be in the best interest of the citizens of Hondo.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HONDO, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Fee Schedule in Appendix A, Section A13.111 is hereby amended to reflect that subsection A13.111(c) is now subsection A13.111 (b) and shall read as follows:

Section A13.111 Schedule of rates and charges

(b) Schedule B. Permit Fees for Citizens Collection Station.

Yearly Permit Fee:	\$30.00 per person
One-Time Use Fee:	\$20.00 per person

Section 2. SEVERABILITY

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall

not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect on July 28, 2014.
